VIVIENNE ABRAHAM WAS BORN IN MELBOURNE 2 FEBRUARY 1920 AND GRADUATED LL.B. HAVING STUDIED FROM 1937 UNTIL 1966. SHE AND HER SISTER SHIRLEY, BORN 28 FEBRUARY 1922, WERE ACTIVE IN A NUMBER OF PEACE, PACIFIST AND CONSCIENTIOUS OBJECTOR SUPPORT GROUPS FROM THE 1940S TO 1989 (SHIRLEY DIED EARLIER). VIVIENNE WAS EDITOR OF *THE PEACEMAKER* FROM 1953 UNTIL 1955, JOINT EDITOR WITH SHIRLEY 1964-1968, AND EDITOR FROM 1969 UNTIL 1971, WHEN IT CEASED PUBLICATION.
