After war service in the British Army from 1940 to 1945, Samuel worked in the Research Department of the Foreign Office, where much of his work involved translating Nazi documents. In 1947 he was ap pointed Se nior L ecturer i n G ermanic Languages and then Foundation Professor in 1951 until his retirement in 1968. He published many works on German literature. He was a F ellow of t he A ustralian Society of the Humanities and the Australian College of Education and a Commander of the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany. He died in 1983.
