HISTORICAL NOTE	Charles Edward Howlett was born in North Melbourne in 1897 and was educated at Melbourne Grammar School and the University of Melbourne, where he graduated in Arts (1919) and Law (1921). He was admitted to the Victorian Bar in 1922. He studied French in Grenoble during 1927-29 and undertook primary school training in Melbourne in 1931. In 1932 he began a teaching career at Melbourne Grammar School. Howlett was president of the Ship Lovers' Association and in 1950 sailed the world in a Finnish barque teaching English to the crew. He died in 1973.
