HISTORICAL NOTE	Andrew Hewett commenced his political activism while he was a secondary student at Melbourne High School in 1970-1971. He was a member of the Australian Labor Party [ALP] 1970-1971 and was a founding member Melbourne University Students Representative Council and Vice-President in 1974. Hewett was an Executive member of the Vietnam Moratorium Committee 1971-72; a member of the Communist Party of Australia 1974-1983 in various states and holding various national positions. He was an effective Secretary of the Campaign for International Co-operation and Disarmament [CICD] 1976-1980; state organiser of the Australian Union of Students 1975 and a member of its National Executive in 1976; founding member of the Victorian Secondary Students Union 1970 and organiser and sole full time employee of People for Nuclear Disarmament 1981-1983.
