HISTORICAL NOTE	The Fairfield Falcons, a women's Australian Rules football team, was established in 1990 to give women the opportunity to play competition football in the Women's League in Melbourne. It took a couple of seasons before the Fairfield Falcons were able to win a match or two. However, the players were enthusiastic and kept training and playing until the team was one of the best in the Women's League. The Fairfield Falcons celebrated their tenth anniversary at McDonnell Park in Northcote in October 1999 with Aussie Rules and soccer matches between past and present players. The team continued to take on and train new players and to provide women who wanted to play footy the opportunity to do so within a supportive and encouraging environment.
