Creator's Historical Note

Germaine Greer, author, journalist, broadcaster, feminist and conservationist was born in Melbourne, Australia on January 29, 1939. She was educated at Star of the Sea College, Gardenvale, studied English and French literature and language at the University of Melbourne, (BA Hons) and graduated MA (Hons I) from the University of Sydney with a thesis on Byron's satiric verse, and was a Senior Tutor in English (1963-1964). Greer earned a PhD from the University of Cambridge on Shakespeare's Early Comedies and was appointed Lecturer at the University of Warwick (1967-1972). Greer was one of the first women appointed full members of Cambridge University Footlights Dramatic Club and subsequently played roles in comedies for television, with regular appearances on radio and television continuing throughout her career. A contributor and editor for the underground press Oz and Suck magazines, Greer was also a gardening columnist 'Rose Blight' for Private Eye in the late 1960s and 1970s. Greer has written widely throughout her career for the mainstream press as a journalist, columnist and reviewer.

In 1970 Greer published The Female Eunuch, which explored the limitations on women's lives and selves in the wider context of the liberation movements of that time. It created a shock wave of recognition in women around the world, became an international bestseller and a landmark in the history of the women's movement and was reprinted and widely translated. This launched Greer's career as an author and was followed by a series of popular and academic books including: The Obstacle Race: The Fortunes of Women Painters and their Work 1979, Sex and Destiny: The Politics of Human Fertility 1984, Shakespeare 1986, The Madwoman's Underclothes selected journalism 1964-1985 1986, Kissing the Rod: An Anthology of Seventeenth Century Women's Verse (coedited with Susan Hastings, Jeslyn Medoff and Melinda Sansone) 1988, Daddy we hardly knew you 1989, The Uncollected Verse of Aphra Behn (Ed.) 1989, The Change: Women Ageing and the Menopause 1991, The Collected Works of Katherine Philips: The Matchless Orinda (vol. III The Translations) with Dr Ruth Little 1993, Slip-Shod Sibvls: Recognition Rejection and the Women Poet 1995. The Surviving Works of Anne Wharton (edited with Susan Hastings) 1997, The Whole Woman 1999, John Wilmot Earl of Rochester 1999, 101 Poems by 101 Women (ed.) 2001, The Boy (2003), Poems for Gardeners (ed.) 2003, Whitefella Jump Up: The Shortest Way to Nationhood (Quarterly Essay) 2003-2004, Shakespeare's Wife 2007, On Rage 2008, and White Beech 2013. Greer is in addition the publisher of several volumes of seventeenth century women's writing under the imprint Stump Cross Books.

Greer taught at the Universities of Tulsa (1979-1983) and Warwick (c. 1989-2003). She is the president of the invertebrate charity Buglife and the founder of Friends of Gondwana Rainforest charity which manages the Cave Creek Rainforest Rehabilitation Scheme in Southern Queensland. In 2013 Greer sold her archive to the University of Melbourne, with proceeds to benefit Friends of Gondwana. Greer is the recipient of numerous scholarships, honours and awards.

Scope and Content of Series

The Greer Archive has been made available due to its historical and research importance. Statements which form part of the collection are not made on behalf of the University and do not represent the University's views. It contains material that some researchers might find confronting. This includes: explicit language and images that reflect either the attitudes of the era in which the material was originally published or the views of the creators of the material but may not be considered appropriate today; names, images and voices of deceased Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in published and unpublished printed material, audio recordings and photographs; graphic descriptions of medical conditions and treatment.

This series, The Papers of Germaine Greer Third Tranche, comprises two units of material delivered to the University of Melbourne Archives by Germaine Greer in March 2017.

Unit 1 contains correspondence and other paper records relating to Greer's print journalism, radio appearances and television appearances [dated 2011], as well as correspondence from photographer Derek Brook relating to photographs he had taken of Greer in the late 1960s. Unit 2 contains the group of photographs referred to by Brook in the correspondence, including photographs of Greer and her one-time husband Paul du Feu on their wedding day.

Related series in the archive containing earlier records: Print Journalism 1959-2010 [2014.0046], Television 1968-2013 [2017.002], Radio 1972-2010 [2017.0011] and Photographs 1953-2011 [2014.0054].

The items in this series have been rehoused using archival grade materials. Paper records have been rehoused in acid free folders in the order in which they were received, and original titles have been retained and inscribed on the new folders. All photographic prints have been housed in appropriate archival grade sleeves. Correspondence and materials relating to Greer's print journalism, and television/radio appearances are exclusively from 2011, while other materials such as newspaper clippings and articles about Greer vary, with several clippings discussing Christine Wallace's biography of Greer 'The Untamed Shrew', and a copy of OZ magazine from 1972 with the headline 'Germaine Greer's husband flashes cock'.

The topics covered throughout Greer's 2011 print, television and radio work vary largely and reflect both her interests and the current affairs of the time including: politics, feminism, art, architecture, pets and gardens, and William Shakespeare. All photographs in this series are black and white gelatin silver prints that were taken by professional photographer Derek Brook in the late 1960s. Derek Brook was a friend of Germaine's in the 1960s in London. When Brook died, in 2011, he left his photographic archive to lifelong friend Dave Cullinan. In October 2016, Cullinan got in touch with the University of Melbourne Archives as he wanted to contact Greer and offer her some of Brook's photographs. In March 2018 Greer hand delivered the photographs to the University of Melbourne Archives. The series includes 17 single photographs and three contact prints. Each photograph has been listed as a single item and item numbers have been inscribed in soft pencil on the back. Many of the photographs contain inscriptions listing the photographer's details, hand written on the back of the print: "Derek Brook, via Fontana, Dezza Alta, Diecimo, 55020, Lucca, Italy'.

The first photograph in the series is a photo montage, constructed by Brook to illustrate an article in The Sydney Morning Herald about kaleidoscopes. The image is a close-up of Greer's face printed several times and arranged on brown cardboard. The next two photographs in the series are portraits of Germaine Greer taken in the late 1960s, in one Greer holds a cigarette.

The remaining 15 photographic prints in the series are portraits of Germaine Greer and Paul du Feu, taken in July 1968 on the day of their wedding. Three of the prints are proof sheets containing a total of 108 individual images from the photo shoot and the other 14 prints are individual photographs. In these images the photographer's attention is clearly on the new bride, as she appears primarily in focus, while Paul du Feu is often blurry. Greer is wearing a handmade crocheted mini dress and du Feu is wearing a corduroy Wrangler jacket. These photographic prints were likely test prints as they have been printed at an angle and contain small white marks indicating that the negatives were dusty at time of printing.
