<p><b>Historical Note</b></p> <p>Born in 1896, Teresa Mary Wardell was one of ten children of a Melbourne Catholic family. Her father, Edward Stanfield Wardell, was Deputy Master of the Royal Mint, while her mother Georgina Brady's family had produced several generations of engineers. Teresa's paternal grandfather was the renowned architect William Wilkinson Wardell.</p> <p>Teresa Wardell qualified in nursing at St Vincent's Hospital in 1921 and nursed for the following fifteen years, including a spell as private nurse to Dame Nellie Melba in 1931. Her interest in social welfare led her to join the Catholic Women's Social Guild and to gaining a Diploma in Social Studies from the Victorian Council for Social Training in 1944. From 1936 to 1946 she worked at Melbourne's Catholic Social Service Bureau. From 1946-1947 she worked with the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA) in China and in 1947-1948 with the UN in the Philippines where she worked as a Social Affairs Officer.</p> <p>On her return to Australia Teresa Wardell worked with the Catholic Social Service Bureau again, the Brotherhood of St Laurence, and, from 1951 to May 1953 as a classification officer for the Children's Welfare Department Victoria, at the Royal Park Depot in Parkville. She undertook an UN-funded fellowship in the U.S., Canada and the U.K. in 1953-1954, where she studied services available for juvenile delinquents and unmarried mothers; the first of several such trips. From 1960-1962 she was the Field Work Administrator with the University of Melbourne's Social Work Department. A devout Catholic with wide social welfare involvements, Teresa's principal interests were in the areas of adoption, teenage delinquency, and prison reform. She sat on many committees concerned with these issues up until her death in Melbourne in 1985.</p>

### Scope and Content of Collection

The Records of Teresa Wardell date from 1866 to 1984, and were collected by Teresa Wardell while working for the United Nations, the Victorian government (as a social worker), community service organisations, the University of Melbourne, and while a member of various professional associations. There are also records about her professional writing as an academic, her research into penal reform, adoption, and child welfare, and her personal genealogical research files. The types of records include: children's case files, correspondence, photos, publications, newsletters, reports, hand-written notes, articles, meeting minutes and memorabilia.

The collection was transferred to the University of Melbourne Archives in May 1986. It was allocated the collection identifier 86/123, which was later changed to 1986.0123. The collection is housed in 16 archival boxes/units and measures 2.72 linear metres.

### System of Arrangement

The records did not appear to be in any particular order, so University archivists physically reorganised them into nine series (groups), and described each item at file level. Appraisal decisions were taken at this point and material deemed of little value was weeded from the collection. Each item was then allocated an Item Number identifier (eg 1986.0123.00001), Title, Date Range and Description. The records were re-housed in archival boxes which were allocated an identifier eg Unit/Box: 1986.0123 Unit 1. *Please note:* Earlier documentation of the collection used a numbering system comprising a series and a series sequence number (see 'Previous control number' in the Description). People citing the collection may have used this number when referencing items in the collection.

The series are:

1. Wardell Family: Records regarding Teresa Wardell's family genealogical research including relatives' birth and death certificates (Unit/Box: 1986.0123 Unit 1).
2. UNRRA & China: Material compiled and created by Teresa Wardell while working as an aid worker with the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA) in China from 1946-1947 (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 2 and 1986.0123 Unit 3).
3. Philippines: Upon leaving China in 1947 Teresa Wardell went via San Francisco to Manila, where she took up another UN appointment. This series deals with her work as a Social Affairs Officer for the UN in the Philippines from 1947-1948 (Unit/Box: 1986.0123 Unit 3).
4. Employment: Records relating to Teresa Wardell's employment as a social worker with the Catholic Social Service Bureau, the Children's Welfare Department and the Brotherhood of St Laurence, and later as a lecturer in the Department of Social Studies at University of Melbourne (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 3, 1986.0123 Unit 4 and 1986.0123 Unit 5).
5. Other Organisations of which Teresa Wardell was a committee member/office-bearer: Files regarding Teresa Wardell's membership of social welfare organisations. Material includes minutes, correspondence, newsletters, reports, Wardell's hand-written notes, brochures, news cuttings (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 5, 1986.0123 Unit 6, 1986.0123 Unit 7 and 1986.0123 Unit 8).
6. Professional Associations: Files regarding Teresa Wardell's membership of professional associations including the Australian Association of Social Workers (Unit/Box: 1986.0123 Unit 9).
7. Other interests: Files relating to Teresa Wardell's other interests including penal reform, adoption, and child welfare (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 9, 1986.0123 Unit 10 and 1986.0123 Unit 11).
8. Notes and Writings: These files represent a range of professional writing by Teresa Wardell including lectures for students, drafts of articles and many rough notes (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 11 and 1986.0123 Unit 12).
9. Miscellaneous: The context or significance of these documents was not clear to the University archivists, so a 'Miscellaneous' series was created for them. The records include personal correspondence, memorabilia, photos, certificates, Christmas cards, publications, sheet music (Units/Boxes: 1986.0123 Unit 14, 1986.0123 Unit 15 and 1986.0123 Unit 16).

## Records containing Personal, Sensitive and Health Information

While working for the Victorian State Government Children's Welfare Department Teresa Wardell collected records which contain the names and details of individuals. For example, case cards and case files on children at the Boys and Girls Depots, Royal Park, written by her or other social workers. These files are Item Numbers 1986.0123.00038, 1986.0123.00046, 1986.0123.00047, 1986.0123.00048, 1986.0123.00135 Child Endowment notes (c1958); and, 1986.0123.00143 Notebook (c1957). Because they contain personal and/or sensitive information access to these items is 'restricted', which means clients need to meet special conditions for access (see Access Conditions).

In 2017, the University of Melbourne Archives undertook a project to improve discovery and access to records about people who grew up in orphanages and other out of home 'care' facilities in their collections. This included the Records of Teresa Wardell. An archivist looked through the files; amended or added description to the listing/ this finding aid; moved some restricted material into separate boxes (children's case files dated from c1936 - c1955 were moved to Unit/Box numbers 4 and 5); and, updated a name index of those case files (also restricted).

## Access Conditions

People can apply for access to 'restricted' records (those containing personal and/or sensitive information) by contacting the University Archivist and signing a Deed of Undertaking, see <http://archives.unimelb.edu.au/>. The University of Melbourne Archives coordinates with Find & Connect Support Services to provide extra services for those who grew up in orphanages and other out of home 'care' facilities, and their families. As such we encourage people eligible to apply for access to the restricted records via the support service. Requests for 'open' records (those available to the general public) can be made via the University of Melbourne Reading Room. Restricted records are not available to the general public for 75 years from the date of the last action recorded.
