1. DELAYING THE BUDGET

Mr Fraser reported to "Cabinet" on his interview with the Governor-General the previous day. The Leader said that the morning press had completely distorted the position by suggesting that the Opposition was weakening and seeking some compromise through the Governor-General. The media had misconstrued Mr Fraser's remarks about the Opposition's intention to behave with propriety towards the Governor-General.

2. TACTICS

"Cabinet" met in the course of the day to review tactics, including a censure in the House (not allowed) and a news conference by Mr Fraser (in which he re-emphasised the Opposition's solidarity and determination).
