| <b>HISTORICAL NOTE</b>    | <p>Una Arnold Fraser, née Woolf, was born to Louis and Amy Woolf on 10 July 1902 in Albany, Western Australia. Louis Woolf was an accountant and an active campaigner for Australian Federation in Perth in the late 1890s. He also stood – unsuccessfully – for the first Federal Senate in the elections of March 1901.</p> <p>Una was the younger of two daughters, both of whom were educated privately at home. She was particularly adept at French and music, and acting in repertory theatre.</p> <p>In 1923, at a party on the British battleship ‘Repulse’, she met John Neville Fraser, a lawyer and grazier from New South Wales. Una and Neville married at St Marks Church of England, Darling Point, Sydney, in 1926. They settled at Balpool, near Deniliquin NSW, and in 1943 moved to ‘Nareen’, near Coleraine in western Victoria. They had two children: Lorraine, born in 1927, and John Malcolm, born in 1930.</p> <p>After Neville’s death in 1962, Una Fraser lived in South Yarra, Victoria. She was actively involved in the ‘Alexandra Club’, a primarily social club for women (she was President from 1966–68) and was a benefactor of the National Gallery of Victoria. She was also a keen art collector, acquiring works by Arthur Boyd, Sali Herman, Eric Wilson, Rupert Bunny and Arthur Streeton. She died in Melbourne, Victoria on the 16 May 1998.</p> <p>Una Fraser is survived by two children – Lorraine Whiting (a modernist painter) and Malcolm Fraser (Australia’s twenty-second Prime Minister) – four grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.</p> |

| <b>DESCRIPTION</b>       | <p>This collection comprises letters, newspaper cuttings and photographs collected accumulated by Una Fraser and relating partly to her son, J M (Malcolm) Fraser, Prime Minister of Australia from 1975–1983. It includes letters written by Malcolm Fraser to his parents while he was a student at Tudor House School in New South Wales, from 1941–1943 (when he was aged 11–13). There is also a small number of school reports from about the same period.</p> <p>There are also three scrapbooks of newspaper cuttings, collected by Una Fraser and relating to the political career of her son. The cuttings are from Western District and Melbourne newspapers including the <i>Hamilton Spectator</i>, <i>Warrnambool Standard</i>, <i>Horsham Times</i>, <i>Casterton News</i>, <i>Melbourne Herald</i> and <i>The Argus</i>. The cuttings relate primarily to the political career of J M Malcolm Fraser dating from his pre-selection to the Liberal-Country Party in November 1953 to his post-political career. A small number of cuttings relate to more personal matters such as his engagement to Tamara (Tamie) Beggs in 1956. The cuttings also provide a good overview of rural life and political events in Victoria in the 1950s and 1960s. There are also some photographs and Liberal Party election flyers.</p> <p>Photographs.
