# Canberra: Monday 20 October, 1975

### 1. LEGISLATION

- (a) SOCIAL SERVICES (No. 3)
- Agree (Mr Chipp)
- (b) REPATRIATION ACTS AMENDMENT)
- (c) CONSUMER PROTECTION BILLS

Defer for 30 days - more time for study, particularly by State Governments (Mr Howard). Amend at Committee stage - go ahead on basis of Party Room approval last week (Senator Greenwood).

### 2. TACTICS

(a) MATTERS OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE

Loans Affair (including new material likely to be revealed in Channel 10 interview this evening). Mr Lynch and Mr Sinclair to consult on terms of Urgency, and to advise Mr Fraser.

(b) QUESTIONS

Staffs to work-up questions for tomorrow - again concentrating on Loans Affair.

(c) POSSIBLE GOVERNMENT MOTION

Be prepared for Government motion attacking the Opposition.

### 3. BUDGET DELAY

"Cabinet" discussed the importance of seeking opportunities both inside and outside the Parliament to "sell" our case. Possibility of motions in the Reps. and in the Senate. Highlight Government dishonesty.

### 4. COMMONWEALTH SUPERANNUATION

Mr Fraser reported on an approach from an officer of a public service union, and said there appeared to be a basis for a compromise policy on Commonwealth Superannuation. Mr Lynch to study the papers and, if proposal was reasonable, negotiations should go ahead quietly. Most beneficial result would be a joint announcement from the Opposition and the public service unions.

5. CANBERRA RALLY

Mr Fraser asked his "Cabinet" colleagues to join him for the Rally outside Parliament House tomorrow.

6. NEXT MEETING

Noon tomorrow.
