Biography: William Francis Tulloh was living in the Port Phillip District by the early 1840's, buying land in Melbourne and Geelong. He partnered with Henry "Money" Miller in managing Pieracle Station, north of Dartmoor. He managed property at Mt. Cotterill while Miller was abroad in 1867- 1868. He had died by March 1871.
