Biography:

Edith Eliza Moore was born in 1872, the daughter of Sir Thomas a'Beckett, Judge of the Supreme Court of Victoria, and Isabella, daughter of Sir Archibald Michie. She married Sir William Harrison Moore, Professor of Law in the University of Melbourne and Constitutional Advisor to the Victorian Government, on 10 November 1898. She was prominent in numerous organizations, including the Travellers' Aid Society of Victoria; the Country People's Holiday Camps Association; the National Council of Women; the Housewives' Association; the Women's Rural Industries Company; the League of Women Voters of Victoria and other bodies. She continued to be active after the death of her husband in 1935 and died in 1974.

Scope and Content of Series

Personal correspondence, including letters from brother Gilbert a'Beckett, Sir Thomas a'Beckett and her husband, 1902-1960; Companies' and Societies' material (circulars, advertisements, information notes, minutes, reports) 1917-1951; Newspaper cuttings, invitations etc., 1929- 1954; accounts, tax assessment; Diaries, 1901-1958; engagement books, 1938-1961; papers given by Lady Moore to various societies; pattern books, architect's drawing, etc.

Archival History

Listed by Ann Smith October 1965. Typescript list converted to item data by Christine Elias November 2019.

Due to its high use, the entire collection was re-boxed into Type 2 archive boxes, and transferred into acid-free folders. Some of the more fragile items were placed in Mylar or other inert plastic sleeves. Items in each group were checked against the original listing, as the correspondence particularly, was out of order. Items needed to be re-ordered to match the lists. Note a booklet titled: Thrift in Time and Talents (No. 4/2/6) appears to be missing.

Some items seem to have been added after the original transfer. The typed list appears to have been updated, however, several additional items needed to be manually added to the list. These have been added in pencil. Note particularly the addition of 5 letters from 1914 that have been inserted at the end of Group 3 (Other Correspondence). The added items were numbered 3/14/1 to 3/14/5, but as little is known about their contents, may require further research.
