Biography:

F.G. Elford was born on 5 March 1907 in Ballarat. On completing the Leaving Certificate at Ballarat High School, he joined the Education Department as a Junior Teacher on Probation (27 January 1925) and in the following year entered the Melbourne Teachers' College. He left the College in December 1929, having completed his B.Sc. degree in 1926-28 and Dip.Ed. in 1929. He was to take and complete the course for B.Ed. in 1936. In January 1930 he returned to Ballarat High School as an assistant teacher, remaining there, except for a brief period at Melbourne High School, until January 1938, when he was appointed as a lecturer to the Teachers' College. In February 1945 he was appointed part time demonstrator in Geology at the University of Melbourne. In 1948 he left the Teachers' College to become a full time Senior Administrative Officer in the Science and Medical Faculty, and was appointed Deputy Registrar in April 1966. He died on 18 June 1970. Throughout his working life F.G. Elford was an enthusiastic nature-lover, and did much to promote nature-study in the schools through his courses at the Teachers' College and through school broadcasts.

An Editor's note at the head of the first (15 September 1938) explains that Mr Elford is a member of a Departmental committee which has been devoting special attention to visual education. At the Committee's request, a series of articles on the subject will be published in the Gazette. Elford was at the time lecturing at the Melbourne Teachers' College, 15 September 1938 - 15 September 1939. Cleveland Makes It, Four R's, by Karl Detzer, condensed from The Kiwanis Magazine (on teaching geography by radio), from Reader's Digest, April 1939; What is Geography?; The Position of Geography in the High Schools of the Netherlands, by H Eggink, reproduced from Journal of Geography, Volume 36, No. 3, March 1937; Programme for Conference of History and Geography Teachers, Wednesday, April 12th in Melbourne, chaired by Professor G S Browne, under the auspices of the Australian League of Nations Union, Victorian Branch, conference convened to provide teachers with an opportunity to consider the problems and possibilities of Teaching History and Geography as an integrated course, and learn of actual experiments being carried out in Victoria; Notes headed Science; Primary course: Objective Scales, 1938/9, on maintaining ratio of teaching to academic marks of student teachers; Social Studies - Geography, 1939, details of individual work, instructions to students; History courses for combined grades V - VI in rural schools; Combination of grades VII - VIII History in the small rural school; Notes for demonstration lesson; Notes for demonstration lesson in geography at University High School, sub-intermediate; Melbourne Technical College half-yearly test, June 1938, in Petrology 1 and Geology 1 (evening); Notices from A J Law to staff on addition of erosion and reafforestation to curriculum to Grades 6 - 8 and about staff meetings; Course of study: erosion and afforestation; Melbourne Teachers College Social Studies - History; Report on Training of Teachers in Social Studies - Geography, presumably by Elford.
