The firm began in 1914 as an amalgamation of two real estate firms, W.H. Allard and Co., founded in 1882 by William Henry Allard (1859-1927) and a firm founded in 1892 by W.L. Baillieu (1859-1936) but managed by his brother, Arthur Sydney Baillieu (1872-1943), from 1904 onwards. Baillieu Allard Pty Ltd was widely known throughout Australia and was responsible for the exchange of some of the most expensive properties in Melbourne. The firm was bought out by Knight Frank c.1990.
