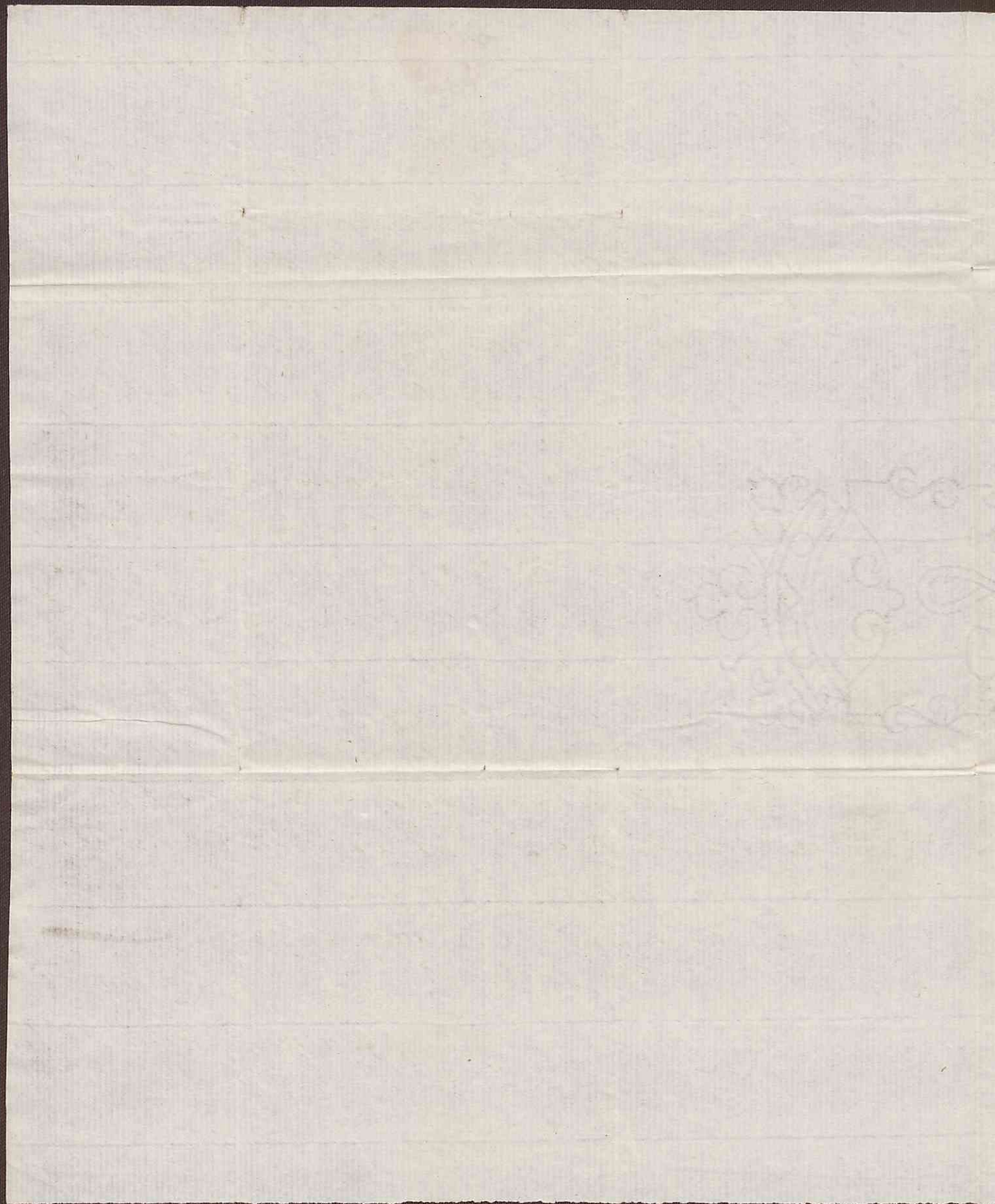

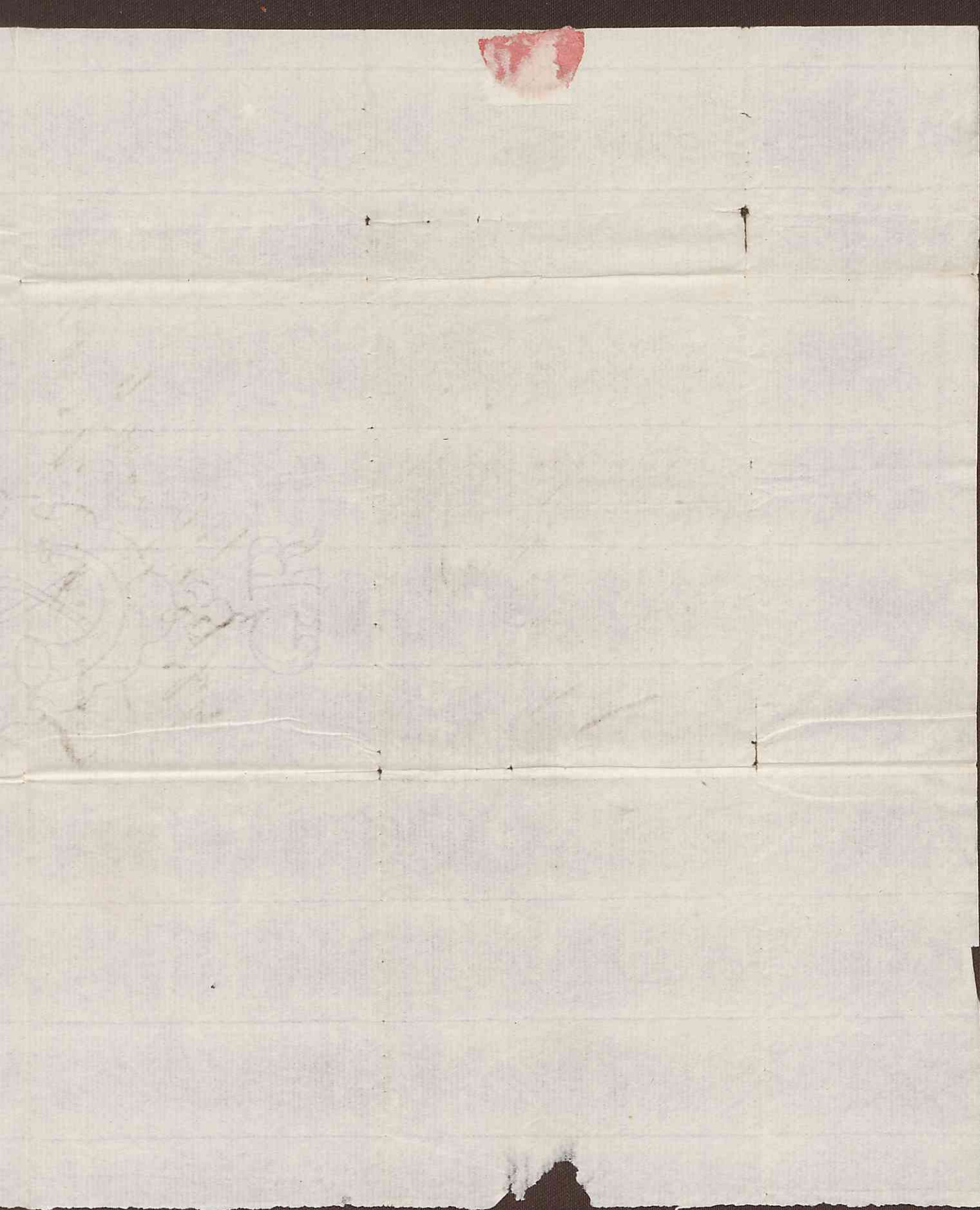
Liverpool. May 17. 1770
