John Doe Planter by Henry John Hoff his Attorney  
Complainant of Richard Roe of the parish of Trelawny in the  
County of Cornwall and Island aforesaid Planter of a plea of  
Trespass & Detournment of farm &c. For ~~use and~~ that whereas  
Richard Bright of that part of the United Kingdom of Great  
Britain and Ireland called England & Town on the 5<sup>th</sup>  
day of March in the year of our Lord 1818 at the parish of  
Trelawny in the County of Cornwall & Island aforesaid did  
demise set and to farm let unto the said John Roe and his  
assigns All those Negro and other Male and female Slaves  
upon and belonging to a certain Plantation or Sugar called &  
known by the name of Garrode situated lying and being in  
the parish of Trelawny in the County of Cornwall aforesaid  
and named as follows that is to say Glasgow William Jack  
Pier, Cyrus, Sancho, Peter, Jamaica, Robert, Pompey, Jack,  
France, Quamin, Johnny, London, Johnny, George, Quamin

the said Slaves. To Have and to Hold the said  
Negro Sothor Male & female Slaves with the future Issue offspring  
and Increase of the females of the said Slaves unto the said  
John Doe and his assigns from the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March  
in the year aforesaid for and during and unto the full end and  
Term of 21 Years from thence next ensuing and fully to be  
complete and ended By virtue of which said devise the said  
John Doe was and became possessed of the said  
Negro and other Male & female Slaves and was so thereof  
possessed until the said Richard Roe afterwards toward the  
5<sup>th</sup> day of March aforesaid, in the year aforesaid, at  
the parish of Fulham in the County of Cornwall aforesaid  
with force and Arms &c. did take possession of the said  
Negro & other Male & female Slaves and him the said John Doe  
from his former thereof, his Term therein aforesaid not being yet  
ended, did eject expel and remove, and him the said John Doe  
being so thereof ejected expelled and removed from his possession  
thereof aforesaid hath hitherto withheld and still withholdeth, &  
other enormities to him then & there did against the peace  
of our Sovereign Lord the King that now is and to the  
Damage of the said John Doe of S  
Current Money of the Island aforesaid & therefore he sueth &c



Sir,

You may perceive by the above Declaration in Court, that I am sued for the several Negro or other Slave Stolen therein mentioned or for some part thereof, to which I have no title; if therefore you claim any share and intend to defend it, you must appear at the next Magistrates Supreme Court of Judicature to be holden at the Town of Sainte Eglise de la Vega, in the County of Saint Domingo, in the said Island, the first Monday in October, by some Writ of that Court and make your defence; otherwise I shall suffer Judgment to pass against me by default, and you will be turned out of possession.
