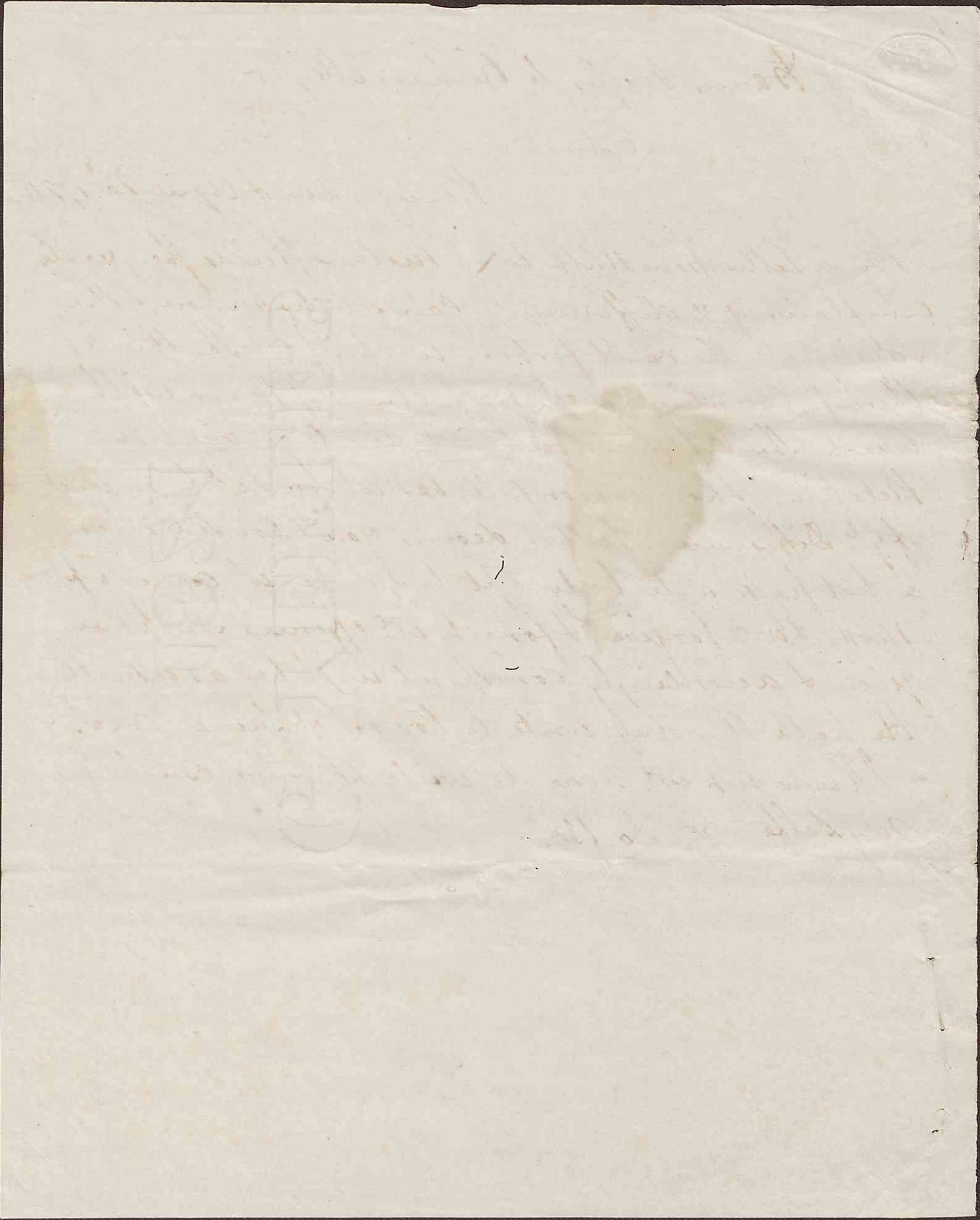
Francis Meyler to Richard Meyler

Haverfordwest April 20th 1724.

By a letter from Ruth to her Mother friends she greatly
complains of a difference of Cause between you & she,

which she left London, in order to go visit her
Relations, how sorrowfull her return sh^d. be on acct^e.
of y^e. Difference. Father desires you'd consider her
a hot passionate body apt to speake wth comes upper.
most. God forgive & forget wth offences she have
given & accordingly correspond with her as usuall.
We hath this day write to her on y^e. same acct^e.

I know not wth more to write therefore conclude
my selfe y^r. Lo. Br.
