NOTE:** Joseph Gardiner Mack married Anna Austin in New Norfolk in 1836. They arrived in the Port Phillip District in 1840 and ran the Woolpack Inn at Geelong prior to commencing pastoral life. The author of the journal, Mrs John Caverhill was the daughter of Joseph and Anna Mack.
