HAWKER'S LICENCE. FOUR-WHEELED VEHICLE, £2.

WHEREAS

David Hatched Jones
of *Naracoorte* hath paid the sum of
TWO POUNDS to me as fee for a Hawker's Licence, now I, the undersigned, Treasurer
of South Australia, do hereby authorise the said *David*

Hatched Jones to hawk and carry about any
Goods, except intoxicating liquors, for sale, in any part of the said State, in any cart,
wagon, or other vehicle, or with any horse, ass, mule, or other beast of burden of which
he shall be in the actual charge, until the twenty-fifth day of March now next ensuing,
or until this Licence shall be forfeited.
