HAWKER'S LICENCE. FOUR-WHEELED VEHICLE, £2.

WHEREAS David offetches forces
of Navacaote hath paid the sum of
TWO POUNDS to me as fee for a Hawker's Licence, now I, the undersigned, Treasurer of South Australia, do hepeby authorise the said
Goods, except intoxicating liquors, for sale, in any part of the said State, in any cart,
wagon, or other vehicle, or with any horse, ass, mule, or other beast of burden of which he shall be in the actual charge, until the twenty-fifth day of March now next ensuing,
or until this Licence shall be torfeited.
Dated this 29 day of Settler 1922
