NOTE ON LISTING	 When received, the records were in little apparent order and stored fairly randomly in files, plastic bags and cartons. There was sometimes evidence in the file titles of the meaning which Gertrude Berger attached to the contents; where these were evident they have been retained and the contents of the file described. These files nevertheless sometimes contained documents which did not seem well placed in relation to the file title. In general, rather than remove them, they have been noted in the list and researchers should browse the whole list for items on particular subjects. Cross references have also been given in the body of the list as a guide to related material where possible. At the macro level, artificial series have been created and arranged around the major institutional activities of Gertie Berger's life as closely as possible in chronological order. Thus the first series relates to her employment and activities as a Nurse Tutor at Prince Henry's Hospital, Melbourne; the second with her activities as member and interpreter for the International Council of Nurses, 1961; and so on. Where a document exists which does not show direct evidence of Miss Berger's involvement with an organisation, but which she seems to have kept for information, it is listed at the end of the series document, or with Series 11: Personal Records, when no connection with the activities of a particular institution could be discerned.

PROVENANCE NOTE:

These are the records of Gertrude (Gertie) Berger created and collected during her working life as a Nurse Tutor at Prince Henry's Hospital from the 1950s, and in the course of her involvement with nursing organisations in Victoria and internationally from that time until well after her retirement in 1984.

Gertie Berger was born in 1913 in Germany where she eventually trained and qualified as a nurse, becoming a Charge Sister. In May 1939 she left Germany for England to escape religious persecution under the Nazis. Her father, Walter Berger, had already left Germany and was eventually sent to Australia and interned as an enemy alien. Miss Berger remained in England nursing until 1949 when she was able to join her father in Australia. She recommenced nursing at the Eye and Ear Hospital in Melbourne and eventually, in 1955, received a Florence Nightingale

Scholarship for a 1956 course in Nurse Teaching at the College of Nursing Australia. Once she had trained, the Eye and Ear Hospital wanted to retain her services as a Nurse Tutor but could not afford to do so. She commenced employment as a Nurse Teacher with Prince Henry's Hospital in 1957

From the time that Miss Berger qualified as a Sister Tutor in the mid 1950s, her expertise in nursing education led her from direct teaching at Prince Henry's Hospital, Melbourne, to examining with the Victorian Nursing Council and eventually to curriculum design for them as their Education Officer.

Miss Berger also served on committees of the major nursing organisations in Victoria, usually providing input into their educational programs and campaigns. For example, she served on the Florence Nightingale Committee of Australia, Victorian Branch, where she chaired a joint Committee on Nursing Education, and the College of Nursing, Australia, Victorian State Committee where she convened post-graduate Study Days. She also contributed to the Goals in Nursing Education campaign which was cooperatively organised by the ^{*}ANF, the CNA and the FNCA. The complex detail of her involvement with these various committees is revealed in the records below. [^{*} See abbreviations below.]

This collection also demonstrates Miss Berger's interest in nursing and nursing education internationally through her involvement with the International Council of Nurses and the Florence Nightingale Old Internationals. The records held here of her visits to ICN Congresses also show her to have been a person of wide cultural interests, easily making friends, who, along with her students, regarded her with great affection. Gertie Berger died in Melbourne on January 14, 2006.

Her activities covered in this collection, in rough chronological order, are:

1955: Was given the Florence Nightingale Scholarship for a 1956 course in Nurse teaching at the College of Nursing Australia.

1956: Completed College of Nursing, Australia, Sister Tutors post-graduate course.

1957: Became Sister Tutor at Prince Henry's Hospital, Melbourne, a post which she retained until 1966. In 1973 she retired from the Victorian Nursing Council and rejoined Prince Henry's teaching part time until her second retirement in February 1986 at the age of 73.

c.1957: Tutor at the College of Nursing Australia for a few sessions in early years after graduation.

1961: German interpreter for International Council of Nurses, Melbourne Congress, and a member of the Florence Nightingale Old Internationals. She also maintained a life long interest in the international Red Cross.

1957 on: Examiner for Victorian Nursing Council. She was initially State Examiner for the Eye and Ear Hospital papers and her involvement with the VNC later encompassed many committees. She became, for example, a member of their General [Nurse] Training Working Committee and Curriculum Development Committee in 1961/1962 to prepare by thorough investigation material to prove well for changes in the general nurse training program and its success in implementation.

1966: Took up position of Education Officer with Victorian Nursing Council, Department of Health, Victoria, and consequently resigned from Prince Henry's Hospital and as the Vice-Chairman of the Nurse Educators Section of the RVCN. Held this position until her retirement at age 60 in 1973 when she returned to Prince Henry's Hospital part time.

1957 on: Member of the Nurse Educators Special Interest Group of the Royal Victorian College of Nursing until its dissolution.

1973: Chair of Joint Committee on Development of Nursing Education for Florence Nightingale Committee Victoria and College of Nursing Australia, Victorian State Committee. Miss Berger's association with the Florence Nightingale National and Victorian Committees was a long one. The FNC promoted and raised money for post-basic nursing and gave scholarships for that purpose. They financially supported the College of Nursing Australia with their non-government supported courses. Miss Berger was at various times Chair of the Victorian Branch and attended National FNC interstate and state meetings. She was on the combined fundraising committee of the FNC, CNA and RVCN which held annual appeals, sales of items such as pens, wrapping paper, badges, appeals to business and so on. She was also on the FNC scholarship selection committee and occasionally its Chair.

1973: Council Member and on the Education committee of College of Nursing, Australia national body; Chair of Victorian State Committee 1972-1974 on two occasions.

1977-1980: Elected member of the College of Nursing, Australia Federal Council.

pre-1978: Royal Australian Nursing Federation, Victorian Branch Council member; acted as their representative on the National Council of Women of Victoria's Women and Employment Committee c.1976-1978.

1978: Royal Australian Nursing Federation, Victorian Branch Council Monitor.

1980: Convenor of CNA,VSC Study Days Committee. Member of Working Party for Ministerial Review of Shortage of Nurses. Chair of Executive Committee of CNA,VSC.

1986: Retired from active nursing and teaching in February 1986; celebrated her birthday on 13 March of that year.

1985-1986: Member RANF, VB Associate and Non-Practicing Members Group.

1985: Gertie Berger Award established by Victorian State Committee of the College of Nursing Australia.

1985-1988: Member of Executive of CNA, VSC.

1988: Member of CNA,VSC Working Party to review the Nurses Act.

1988: Convenor of CNA Working Party to establish a National Nursing Archive.

This series contains evidence of both her professional and social life associated with the Quadrennial Congresses of the ICN in particular.
