		system, e.g. Australian Universities Sports Association). The files contain correspondence and related papers on a range of matters and provide a record of the activities of the Sports Union. They also contain evidence of Tickner's broad sporting interests which extended beyond Melbourne University. It became apparent during processing of the Sports Union Archive that a large amount of the material transferred consisted of W.K. Tickner's record keeping system (referred to when transferred as the "second accession"). The original order of Tickner's files appears to have been an alphabetical arrangement by subject, sometimes further divided by years. The files had been rearranged at various times, and it proved impossible to reconstruct the original order completely, but the alphabetical sequence used in the office has been reconstructed as far	
		as possible, and original file titles transcribed where evident – there are thus some titling idiosyncrasies. For ease of use, series and item numbers have been applied based on the alphabetical arrangement. Tickner's working files of University and Sports Union committees have generally been maintained, when annotated, but in most cases should not be considered the official record.
