HISTORICAL NOTE	The first Ormond Professor of Music, G.W.L.Marshall-Hall, arrived in 1891, and as a practical complement to his lectures he in 1894-5 established the University Conservatorium of Music. The second professor, Franklin Peterson, introduced a public examination system at the Conservatorium which led to the creation of the Australian Music Examinations Board in 1918. The Conservatorium was the nucleus of a Faculty of Music created in 1926 (and retained its identity officially until 1975). At its creation, the Faculty (i.e. the board of the Faculty) was to consist of: the Ormond Professor, no more than ten members of the Conservatorium (teaching staff), two members of the Conservatorium Finance Committee, five persons outside the Conservatorium, the President of and one other member of the Professorial Board.
