- 3-3-41. Seamens Inst. have had no mail for a/n and never heard of her until enq. "Authorities" adv. ship in which she left Aust. overdue and personnel taken POW.
- 6-3-41. Adv. S. Africa result of enq. and that trying Dept. Ext. Affairs.
